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Alerts:

In the event of an emergency, employees are alerted by:

- The Sounding of an alarm
- Verbal Announcement

<u>Identify the emergency signal for each emergency situation (i.e. earthquake, fire, general evacuation):</u>

- *Fire* Automatic fire detection alarm system and manual pull alarm system (located at exit doors). The back-up alert will be a verbal communication. Everyone should evacuate to the designated Evacuation Assembly Area Anderson County Courthouse parking lot @ the corner of N. Murray Av. & Whitner St. (sign posted).
- General Evacuation (Bomb Threat, etc.) Verbal communication ("Code Black" for bomb threat). Everyone should evacuate to the designated Evacuation Assembly Area Anderson County Courthouse parking lot @ the corner of N. Murray Av. & Whitner St. (sign posted).
- *Shelter-in-Place* Verbal communication. Everyone should report to the designated shelter-in-place location for additional instructions **Interior Corridor.**

Policy:

In the event of fire or other emergency, ALL employees shall evacuate immediately.

Routes:

In the event of an emergency, employees shall evacuate by means of the *nearest* available marked exit.

Extinguishers:

In the event of a fire, the following individuals are authorized to use portable fire extinguishers to attempt to extinguish fires before evacuating:

• Only employees trained to use a fire extinguisher should attempt to suppress a fire if it is a small "incipient" fire (only if the employee is comfortable doing so), or to clear a path to safety.

"Incipient" infers a fire that has just begun and is of such size that poor visibility, smoke inhalation, and high temperatures have not reached the degree to require the use of breathing apparatus.

Operations:

Critical operations shutdown procedures are not required, because no employees are authorized to delay evacuation for this purpose.

Duties:

No employees are assigned to perform medical or rescue duties during emergency evacuation situations

Evacuation Monitors:

Evacuation Monitor – This is the person responsible for covering the front desk. The Evacuation Monitor will make a final check to ensure all employees and visitors have evacuated their area. The Evacuation Monitors will then report the occupancy status report to onsite emergency personnel.

Assembly:

After an emergency evacuation, employees are to gather in the following location(s):

• Economic Development – Anderson County Courthouse Parking Lot at the corner of N. Murray Ave & Whitner St. (sign is posted)

Accounting:

After an emergency evacuation, the procedure for accounting for all employees is:

Evacuation Monitor will ensure that all employees from their building have reached the Evacuation Assembly Area, and provide a building occupancy status report to onsite emergency personnel.

Additional Evacuation Plan and Procedures:

"Shelter-in-Place"

"Shelter-in-Place" means selecting an interior room or rooms within a facility, or ones with no or few windows, and taking refuge there. Employees should go to a "Shelter-in-Place" within the building when it is safer to remain indoors rather than to evacuate.

- Tornado Warning & Severe Weather Interior Corridor
- Chemical, Biological, etc. Interior Corridor

Emergency Alert Type/Sequence

<u>Fire</u>: Automatic fire detection alarm system and manual pull alarm system (located at exit doors). Verbal communication. Everyone should evacuate to the designated Evacuation Assembly Area – Anderson County Courthouse parking lot @ the corner of N. Murray Av. & Whitner St. (sign posted).

<u>General Evacuation (Bomb threat, etc.)</u>: Verbal communication ("<u>Code Black</u>" for bomb threat). Everyone should evacuate to the designated Evacuation Assembly Area – Anderson County Courthouse parking lot @ the corner of N. Murray Av. & Whitner St. (sign posted).

<u>Shelter-in-Place</u>: Verbal communication shelter-in-place. Everyone should report to the designated shelter-in-place location for additional instructions – **Interior Corridor**.
